



Join us

We aim to offer courses that learners want and understand that everyone has their own reasons for joining a class. We will try to help whether you are looking for qualifications to improve your job prospects or are looking for a new interest and to meet new people.

We offer adult learning in the college here at Birley and also in the local community. We have classes in community venues in Charnock, Gleadless, Waterthorpe, and Woodhouse. We work around school terms and many of our courses are initially for 10 weeks but learners are welcome to continue their learning if they wish. Courses which offer a qualification are usually 30 weeks over 3 terms.

Fees: we aim to keep course fees as low as possible. Course fees are made up of an administration fee of £10 plus tuition fees of £2.50 per hour.

Learners who receive a means tested benefit can claim tuition fee remission and pay £10 for a 10 week term.

Literacy and numeracy classes free to all learners. Cooking on a Budget is £10 for 10 weeks.

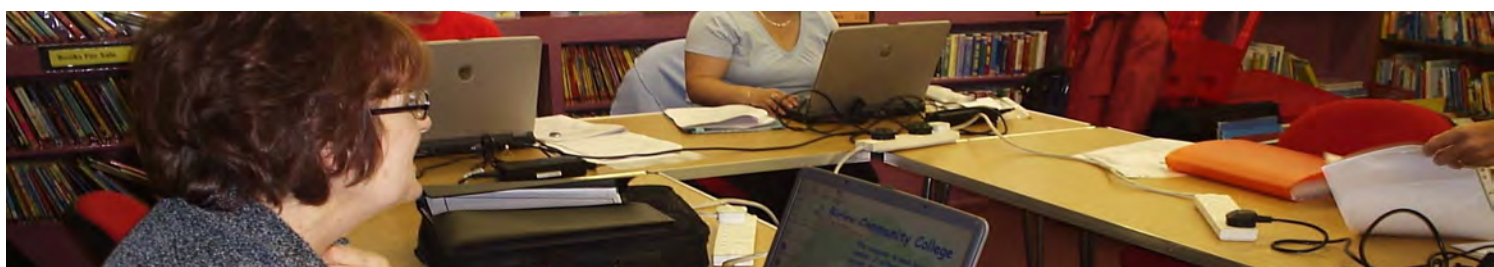

Computer Classes

Computers for Everyone

You may be a complete beginner or have some experience using a computer and want to know more. Gain confidence learning at your own pace in a friendly, relaxed class with tutor support. Learn how to search the Internet, keep in touch with friends and family by email and create and save documents. Organise your computer files with confidence and store your photographs safely.



You may want an IT qualification to show your level of skill using a computer. Whether a qualification is for your own benefit or to help you find a job, our tutors are here to support your learning and help you update your skills.

ITQ level 1

Our ITQ classes give you the opportunity to build your own portfolio of credits towards a level 1 recognised award. Choose how your qualification is made up; learning how to get the best from software applications such as word processing, spread sheets, presentations and using Internet and email services. This is a 30 week course.

European Computer Driving Licence

Work more efficiently with popular software packages: word processing, spread sheets and presentations at level 1 or level 2. Learn how to organise and protect your computer and data. Use Internet Explorer to browse the internet and email using Outlook.



Our ECDL courses are tutor led and we have online learning material to support your learning outside class. Each module is tested online and successful learners achieve an industry recognised qualification. A skills check at the start of the course will show you which level is right for you. This is a 30 week course

Digital Imaging

Use Adobe Photoshop software to be creative with images and improve your photographs. Use the Photoshop toolbox to repair damaged images and experiment with filters and blends to enhance photographs. Change a photograph into a watercolour and a favourite image into an oil painting. Combine images and effects to create personalised artwork from your favourite photos.

Cooking on a Budget

Feeding yourself and your family on a budget shouldn't mean tasteless or unhealthy meals. Get creative with our cooking course. Learn and improve cooking, baking and decorating skills in a friendly class. This is a learner centred course where the class decides what to make. Learn how small changes to recipes can help you to save money and make healthier food choices for you and your family. This course costs £10 for 10 weeks.

Word and Number Skills

Functional Skills

Do you need to improve your word and number skills? Help is at hand in small and friendly classes. You will find out the level you are at and take it from there. Learn at your own pace at pre-entry levels up to level 2. These courses are free.

Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools

This course will suit you if you work or want to work in a support role in school. The course covers a range of units from child and young person development to looking at schools as organisations. This is a 1 year course and you will be required to demonstrate your learning by working in a school in a paid or voluntary role for at least one day a week.
