Key Information Updates

GCSE exams: As GCSE exams are now in full swing, please be aware that there have been some operational changes within the school to facilitate these important assessments. This may include a few classroom changes, which we will communicate to students through tutor time and other channels. There will also be adjustments to the timings of lunches to allow for prompt starts to GCSE exams.

Year 10 mock exams: A reminder that Year 10 mock exams will be taking place in the main exam hall during the week beginning 17th June. We kindly ask that you encourage your Year 10 child to dedicate time to revise in preparation for these assessments. The outcomes of them will be shared with you in the form of a report in July.

Year 7 – 9 assessments: In addition to the exams, all teachers are preparing students for assessments in half-term 6. The outcomes of these assessments will be shared with you as parents/carers in an ADP3 report in July.

Attendance and punctuality: Attendance and punctuality are vital for student success. Regular attendance ensures that students are actively engaged in their learning, allowing them to make the most of the educational opportunities we offer.
